# Learning Activity Series 1 1. Telling Time Review

As you know telling time is a very important skill to have. It helps you to keep track of events during the day, as well as events throughout the week. In the previous telling time program you should have learned to read two different types of clocks in order to tell the correct time. You also should have gotten familiar with reading written time.

Remember that there are two types of clocks; digital and analog. Digital clocks are becoming more common than analog clocks. You can find digital clocks on computers, cell phones, digital tablets, digital watches, and mp3 players, as well as common household appliances like microwaves and stoves. Analog clocks are often found in schools, office buildings, doctor's offices, and government buildings. They are also popular for analog wrist and pocket watches.

Digital clocks display the time in the hour:minute format. (00:00). The time ten o'clock would be displayed like this:

An analog clock uses two hands to show the time. The hour hand (short hand)points to the number of hours while the minute hand (long hand)points to the number of minutes. The time ten o'clock would be displayed like this:
